A University of Toledo student-faculty-alumni steering committee has been appointed by Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president, to promote State Issue No. 2 -- a \$290 million bond issue -- which will appear on the May 4 ballot throughout the state.

Of particular interest to the university, Dr. Carlson said, are the \$6 million for a Community and Technical College and \$7.5 million for the Toledo State College of Medicine, two projects for which funds could be authorized if the bond issue is approved.

Named co-chairman of the coordinating committee are Carl Collins and Daniel Seemann, both of whom are assistant deans in TU's Community and Technical College (UCATC). Dr. Norman Blume, associate professor of political science, and Edward Garrison, assistant dean of TU's College of Engineering, were named to represent the faculty. Edward C. Schmakel, TU's director of alumni relations, will coordinate alumni activities.

Student representatives are Kathy O'Reilly, UCATC representative to TU's Student Senate; John Upham, president of the UCATC Men's Club; and John Hoff, editor-in-chief of The Collegian, TU's student newspaper. A fourth student is to be appointed by the president of the Student Senate.
