Approximately 237 persons will receive degrees Monday (August 30) at Summer commencement ceremonies at The University of Toledo. The ceremonies will be held at 8 p.m. in the TU Field House. Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president, will deliver the commencement address.

Four doctor of philosophy degrees, the largest number to be awarded at a single TU commencement, will be presented to Jerry Lynn Gallentine, 2619 Strauss Avenue; E. Thomas Henkel, 4923 Devonshire; Edward Wright Kleppinger, 9220 Dorr Street (Holland, Ohio); and Thomas TenHoeve, Jr., 1816 Cone Street. The first doctor of philosophy degree was awarded in August, 1964 to William L. Hoover.

TU's first sixth year certificate in educational administration will also be awarded at this time to Mrs. Alice W. Holt, 1201 Anderson (Maumee, Ohio). This certificate requires approximately 60 hours of work beyond the bachelor's degree or one year beyond the master's degree.

The doctor of jurisprudence degree will be presented to four law school graduates. This degree was first awarded at commencement ceremonies last June.

There are 90 master's degree candidates; 132 bachelor's degree candidates; and six associate degree candidates in the University Community and Technical College.

A total of nine students will graduate with honors: two, summa cum laude; two, magna cum laude; four, cum laude; and one, high scholarship in the University Community and Technical College.
