

The Hospital Bond Issue
A statement by William S. Carlson, President
The University of Toledo

There is a demonstrated need for additional hospital facilities in our community. This should be of concern to all of us because it is related to the health of our families and the welfare of the metropolitan area as a whole.

In addition, I am particularly interested in doing all that can be done to hasten the development of the Toledo Medical College with which The University of Toledo will have close relationships.

The bond issue is for \$18 million which is expected to generate, through federal grants, gifts and other sources, a total of about \$50 million to modernize and enlarge seven hospitals and to finance the new St. Luke's Hospital.

The teaching hospital for the Medical School is eligible for two-thirds matching funds which could be a fine incentive to speed action on this important center which is a project of at least \$40 million more.

Since both of these aspects of the bond issue have such significance for so many of us, I urge students, faculty, staff, alumni and friends of the university to support it.
