The University of Toledo Reserve Officers' Training Corps will hold its annual President's Review on Wednesday, November 17, at noon on TU's front campus.* Some 550 TU ROTC cadets and the ROTC's 11 coed sponsors will take part in the review which is given in honor of Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president.

At the review nine senior ROTC cadets will receive Distinguished Military Student awards for academic and military achievement. They are: Jeffrey P. Johnson, Gary J. Berger, William W. Miller, David M. Schuetter, Timothy J. Velker, and George A. Webb, Jr., all of Toledo; Vivian F. Duffy, Ottawa Lake, Mich.; David M. Russen, Jr., West Orange, N.J.; and Terry L. Zimmerman, Montpelier, Ohio.

In addition, the first Veterans' Memorial Scholarship awards will be presented at the review by Mrs. Howard Youngs, chairman of the Veterans Memorial Scholarship Association. One student from each of the sophomore, junior and senior classes was selected to receive the award on the basis of academic achievement, extracurricular activities and honorary awards received during the previous year. Recipients are: Jeffrey P. Johnson, senior, and John F. Mueller, sophomore, both of Toledo; and Michael J. Holobetz, St. Clair, Pa.

The Veterans' Memorial Scholarship Association was formed to provide a fund for sons of TU graduates who lost their lives while serving with the U.S. Military Service during World War II. Since all eligible students have
