FOR RELEASE UPON RECEIPT

The University of Toledo will hold its third commencement of 1966 on Monday, August 29 at 8 p.m. in the TU Field House, with a total of 288* persons scheduled to receive degrees.

Among the degrees to be awarded are 3 doctorates in education (Ed.D.) 4 doctors of jurisprudence (J.D.), 91 masters' degrees, 169 bachelors' degrees and 21 associate (2-year) degrees.

The August degree recipients will bring to more than 1,160 the number of persons receiving degrees from TU in 1966. The total includes 256 persons in January commencement ceremonies and 623 persons who received degrees in June.

Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president, will deliver the commencement address, and Mayor John W. Potter will administer the service pledge. Mayor Potter's sister, Mrs. Mildred Potter Ganss, is a member of the graduating class. She will receive the bachelor of education degree.

The graduates and their families will be guests of President and Mrs. Carlson at a reception in the Student Union following the ceremonies.
