A committee to plan ground-breaking ceremonies for The University of Toledo's new Community and Technical College facilities in Scott Park was appointed today by Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president.

Construction of the new community college facilities in Scott Park will be the first off-campus building undertaken by the University since 1928, when the present West Bancroft Street campus was begun.

A total of \$7.2 million in new construction is planned for the major buildings. The project will be financed with \$6 million in state bond issue funds, \$1 million in Federal matching funds, and \$200,000 in local money, Dr. Carlson said.

Appointed to the committee were: Jesse R. Long, executive vice president; Carl A. Collins, assistant dean, UCATC; Daniel C. Seemann, assistant dean, UCATC; Jerry L. Morrow, director of university relations; David M. Pawlicki, superintendent of buildings and grounds; Robert F. Jackson, professor of mathematics and president of the Faculty Senate; and Mary Romstadt and Richard Highfield, both students in the University Community and Technical College.
