A postponement in ground-breaking ceremonies for The University of Toledo Community and Technical College was announced today by Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president.

The decision to delay the ceremony was made at the request of Ohio Governor James A. Rhodes, who was scheduled to turn the first spadeful of earth at the proposed site in Scott Park, Dr. Carlson said. Charles A. Wertz, who is handling arrangements for Governor Rhodes' October 26 visit to Toledo, said: "I am sorry to announce, but due to the over-extended schedule of the Governor's Day here in Toledo on October 26, it will be impossible for him to participate in ground-breaking ceremonies for the Community College at this time.

"However, he did assure me that at a later date when time permits, he will be happy to properly participate," Mr. Wertz said.

Dr. Carlson said a new date would be set for the ceremonies as soon as arrangements can be made with Governor Rhodes.
