Dr. John D. Millett, chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents, will be in Toledo on Friday (April 14) to discuss capital improvement needs in Ohio public higher education, and the interest of higher education in the proposed Ohio Bond Commission.

Four institutions of higher education in Northwestern Ohio would receive a total of \$66 million if the Ohio Bond Commission -- which will appear as Issue No. 1 on the May 2 ballot -- is approved. The presidents of the four schools -- Dr. Glidden Brooks, Toledo State College of Medicine; Dr. William S. Carlson, The University of Toledo; Dr. William T. Jerome, III, Bowling Green State University; and Dr. William Ramsey, Penta-County Technical Institute -- will appear with Dr. Millett.

The news conference is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. in TU's Student Union.
