The University of Toledo Reserve Officers' Training Corps will hold its 19th annual Honors Day Review Wednesday (May 17) at noon on TU's front campus.

The entire brigade of 750 cadets and their sponsors will pass in review and awards will be presented to cadets who have distinguished themselves in academic and ROTC programs. Although it is scheduled as a regular class session, the public is invited to view the ceremony.

The President's Medal, awarded to the outstanding freshman cadet, will be presented by President William S. Carlson to Cadet Michael J. Murnen (4420 Bowen Rd.).

One cadet from each class also will be honored by the Department of the Army for demonstrating superior ability during the year. These awards will be presented by Col. C.A. Cristin Jr., professor of military science, to John A. Graham III (1430 Ogontz Rd.), senior; John R. Giger (329 Newbury St. Boston, Mass.), junior; James R. Lingvai (536 South Beech St., Bryan, Ohio), sophomore, and James R. Wittman (2118 Copley Dr.), freshman.
