Mrs. Arthur L. Zepf (2035 Central Grove) has been named to serve on the College Advisory Committee of The University of Toledo Community and Technical College by Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president. Mrs. Zepf was a member of the University's municipal board of directors from 1954 until 1967 and had served as vice chairman of the board since 1961.

The primary purpose of the Advisory Committee, according to Newton C. Rochte, dean of ComTech, is to provide insights to the college regarding post high school needs that ComTech may be qualified to serve. He added that the Committee can also assist in interpreting the college to the community. Dr. Rochte believes that Mrs. Zepf's long experience with overall problems of the University will be of unusual help in keeping the college a part of the University after it moves to the Scott Park campus.
