The University of Toledo's Board of Trustees today (Monday, Aug. 4) adopted a new fee schedule, effective with the fall quarter, 1969. The fee increases are subject to any restrictions or provisions which may be adopted by the Ohio General Assembly.

In taking the action the trustees explained that the increase was necessitated by the fact that state appropriations for operating expenses are not expected to produce as much income as had been anticipated in order to meet the University's operating needs.

Dr. William S. Carlson, UT president, said the instructional fee increase would produce about \$600,000 annually which, he said, was the amount by which the state subsidy would fall short of expectations.

Discussing fear of change, Dr. William S. Carlson, president of The University of Toledo, told the University's August 27, 1969 graduating class that they do not share many of the same vast, vague fears that seem to burden so many generations before them.

"Those fears appeared to be more complex than the fear of change that afflicts every generation. It is not merely a clinging to the old that causes a fear of the new except in a very fundamental fact -- that the errors and omissions of yesterday have risen to haunt us and present problems of implementation."

Dr. Carlson cited the fact that war still is the final method in resolving the problems that arise from ideological differences; the pending change in relations between black and white, which he says is feared because Negroes and whites do not know each other; and, also the miracles of the space program which are difficult to assimilate.

He also discussed the fear of ideologies foreign to our own adding that this is one we have experienced on our campus. "Of all the fears to which I have referred, this
