The University of Toledo will hold fall quarter commencement ceremonies on Friday, December 12, at 7:30 p.m. in the UT Field House. Some 380\* students are candidates for degrees.

Dr. Jesse R. Long, executive vice president at UT, will deliver the commencement address. The graduating class will be presented by Dr. William H. Leckie, vice president for academic affairs, and Dr. William S. Carlson, UT president, will confer the degrees. Dr. Ivan G. Harvey, chairman of the department of speech-communication, will call the class roll. The invocation will be given by Rev. Roger Ridgway, campus Protestant chaplain.

In addition to degrees, nine students are scheduled to receive commissions as second lieutenants in the U.S. Army. The commissions will be conferred by Col. Richard A. Shagrin, professor of military science at UT.

David C. Hofmann (427 Notre Dame Ave., Edwardsville, Ill.) is a candidate for the doctor of education degree. Candidates for the doctor of philosophy degree are Robert J. Bieringer (4505 Gilhouse Road), Dorothy E. Dusek (4010 North Tenth, Lincoln, Nebraska), Joan D. Inglis (2529 Montebello), and John L. Kohl (11 York Street, Watertown, Massachusetts).

There are 18 candidates for the doctor of jurisprudence degree, 48 for the master's degree, some 231 for the bachelor's degree and some 76 for the two-year associate degree.

The University holds commencement ceremonies at the end of each quarter and at the end of the summer session.
