Dr. William S. Carlson, president of The University of Toledo, has assumed the chairmanship of the Inter-University Council (IUC) of Ohio, effective July 1.

The IUC membership includes the 12 state-assisted universities in Ohio. The purpose of the organization is to advance higher education in Ohio by all appropriate means, and further the effective interrelation of action among state-assisted institutions of higher education.

Chairmanship of the IUC is rotated annually among the presidents of the 12 state-assisted schools. They are, in addition to UT: University of Akron, Wright State University, Youngstown State University, University of Cincinnati, Bowling Green State University, Central State University, Kent State University, Miami University, Ohio State University, Ohio University and Cleveland State University.
