Some 524\* persons are candidates for degrees to be awarded during The University of Toledo's fall quarter commencement ceremonies scheduled for 7:30 p.m. on Friday, December 15, in the University Field House.

Dr. Edward J. Nussel, chairman of the University's Faculty Senate, will deliver the commencement address, speaking on "The Incongruous Society." Dr. Nussel is professor of education theory and social foundations in the University's College of Education, director of its division of educational foundations and associate director of the College's Center for Educational Research and Services.

Dr. Glen R. Driscoll, president of the University, will confer degrees.

Alice E. Huebner (2119 Evergreen Rd.), assistant professor of English in the College of Arts and Sciences, will be designated professor emeritus. Miss Huebner has served as a full-time faculty member at The University of Toledo during the past 29 years, and earned her bachelor of arts in education and master of arts degrees at UT.

The fall quarter graduating class includes 18 candidates for the doctor of philosophy degree; 30 candidates for the doctor of jurisprudence degree; 10 candidates for the degree of education specialist, which requires a year's graduate study in education beyond the master's degree; 76 candidates for the master's degree; 297 for the bachelor's degree; and, 93 for the two-year associate degree.

Some 11 candidates for degrees also are cadets in the University's Reserve Officers' Training Corps and are scheduled to receive commissions as second lieutenants in the U.S. Army. The commissions will be presented by President Driscoll, and the oaths administered by Lt. Col. John W. McNally, professor of military science at the University and commander of the ROTC unit, during ceremonies in the auditorium of the University's new Law Center at 1 p.m. on December 15.

The University holds commencement ceremonies four times each year, at the conclusion of the fall, winter, spring and summer quarters.
