UT President and Mrs. Glen R. Driscoll annually host the evening to recognize contributors of \$100 or more to The University of Toledo Alumni Foundation.

Fontaine, a well-known stage and screen actress, has appeared in 45 motion pictures including "Suspicion," "The Constant Nymph," "The Women," "Jane Eyre," and "Letter From an Unknown Woman." Her co-stars have included Laurence Oliver, Cary Grant, Fred Astaire, and Paul Newman.

Fontaine first appeared on Broadway in 1954 playing opposite Tony Perkins in "Tea and Sympathy." Her long career on stage has included such plays as "Cactus Flower" and "Private Lives."

The actress also is a historian of American poetry and gives lectures on women poets, Chinese art, and the poems and letters of Elizabeth Barrett and Robert Browning.

Jose Carlos Pinotti, former president of Londrina State University, Parana, Brazil, recently was welcomed to The University of Toledo by UT President Glen R. Driscoll. UT and Londrina State University have had a sister relationship exchanging faculty and students since 1976. Both Mr. Pinotti and his wife have become students at UT and are working for doctorates in higher education and biology, respectively.

Mr. Pinotti served as president of Londrina State University from 1978 to 1982. After getting degrees in law and political science and public administration from Brazilian universities, he completed a master's program at the Brazilian School of Public Administration.

Mr. Pinotti and his wife, Maria Helena, have three children, Jose Carlos, 10; Luis Rodrigo, 7, and Paulo Henrique, 1 1/2. The couple plans to remain in Toledo until spring, 1985, when they expect to complete their degrees at the University.
