SUBJECT: Library/Alumni Association

At an earlier time, during a discussion between the two of us, I mentioned my desire for the library to benefit more significantly from the activities of the Alumni Association. Not inconsequential, in my mind, was the possibility of seeing the library benefit from having it displayed more prominently in fundraising activities of the Alumni Association.
