

Acklin Stamping Company Sold

Tecumseh Products Is New Owner

Sale of the Acklin Stamping Co., 1925 Nebraska Ave., to the Tecumseh Products Co., Tecumseh, Mich., for an undisclosed amount was announced today by R. W. Herrick, president of the Michigan firm.

The merging of operations of the two companies will not affect Acklin's management or staff personnel, said F. C. Greenhill, Acklin president.

Mr. Greenhill said he felt the move will insure further expansion of Acklin's operations in Toledo, insure a constant flow of materials to Tecumseh, and provide more stable employment for Acklin employees.

Acklin Stamping has been doing a large volume of business with Tecumseh Products, supplying pressed metal parts and equipment for compressors and cooling products manufactured by the Michigan firm.

Acklin Stamping Co., in its 42nd year, was founded in 1911 by the late Grafton M. Acklin. Mr. Greenhill, who went to work in the company's plant in 1913, has been president since 1944. There are approximately 600 employees.
