THIS HAS BEEN DONE AND IT IS THE UNANIMOUS OPINION OF THE COMMITTEE AND DON BLAIR, THE INTERNATIONAL REPRESENTATIVE, THAT THIS IS A GOOD SETTLEMENT OF THESE JOBS. I WISH TO THANK EACH COMMITTEEMAN FOR THE INTEREST THEY GAVE TO THIS PROBLEM, AND TO OUR REPRESENTATIVE WHO HELPED WORK THIS OUT, AND ALSO, TO THE ACKLIN MANAGEMENT - SEEMAN, WOOD AND KELLER.
