

# Medical School Blade 6-4-47 Cost Estimated

## Council Told 12 To 15 Millions Required

Establishment of a medical school at the University of Toledo would cost between \$12,000,000 and \$15,000,000, Council's committee of the whole was informed today.

In a letter from Dean Raymond L. Carter, acting president of the university, Council was told that a committee headed by Dr. H. H. M. Bowman has been formed to study the project. The estimate, Dr. Carter wrote, is based on increased building and maintenance costs.

He pointed out that recommendation for a medical college was made during the administration of the late Dr. Henry J. Doermann as university president prior to 1933 and at that time cost was estimated at \$8,000,000.

Vice Mayor DiSalle asked two weeks ago that a study of medical school possibilities be made.
