## TU Medical <sup>BL</sup> School Study Group Named

### Mayor Appoints 12 To Weigh Feasibility Of Creating Facility

A 12-man committee to ascertain the feasibility of establishing a medical school at the University of Toledo was named today by Mayor Damas.

Members are Dr. William S. Carlson, university president; Ward Canaday and Dr. Maurice Schnitker, TU directors; Drs. F. F. A. Rawling, Edward L. Burns, Byron G. Shaffer and Gregor Sido, recommended by the Academy of Medicine; Msgr. Robert A. Maher, representing the Catholic diocese of Toledo.

Wilson L. Benfer, Toledo Hospital administrator, representing the Toledo area hospitals council; John D. Willey, assistant to the publisher of The Blade; Dr. Saul Kelson, medical director of the UAW-Willys Diagnostic Clinic, and Slater Gibson.

The mayor said he would call a meeting of the committee next week. He expects their study to take several months.
