

## 9 Medical College Trustees Confirmed By Ohio Senate

Rhodes' Choices For School In Toledo  
Plus 9 For Cleveland U Win Approval

COLUMBUS, Dec. 30—The Ohio Senate yesterday confirmed Governor Rhodes' appointment of nine trustees for the state college of medicine at Toledo which was created by the special legislative session.

They are Bernard Baker, Paul Block, Jr., J. Slater Gibson, W. W. Knight, Jr., Sister Mary Lawrence, J. Preston Levis, Dr. Frank F.

A. Rawling, Dr. Byron Shaffer, and John Skipton. All are Toledoans except Mr. Skipton, a Findlay resident. Their terms range from one to nine years.

Also confirmed were the governor's appointments of nine trustees for the new Cleveland state university and of Fred Neuenschwander, Wooster, as director of development, replacing George Wilson, who resigned.
