### **Medical College To Study Bones Found In Maumee**

Three skeletons unearthed in Maumee are being turned over to the Medical College of Ohio for study.

Anthropological analysis of the bones is expected to determine whether the remains are those of Indians who died at least 150 years ago.

Arthritic conditions and the type of people these were may also be determined.

The bones were found last week, about six inches underground, opposite the home of Dr. William A. Blank, 315 East Harrison St., while workmen were leveling a knoll which hid a view of the river.
