**CWRU Medical School
Gets 3 Million State Aid**

COLUMBUS—The Board of Regents today approved \$3,000,000 in state funds for support of the Case Western Reserve University Medical School in Cleveland.

The money authorized by the recent Legislature will allow the state to support medical students at the university on the same basis as it supports medical students at Ohio State, the University of Cincinnati, and the Ohio Medical College in Toledo.

The state pays \$4950 per student in calculating aid to medical colleges.

The assistance to the Cleveland institution enables the state to support a medical college in the state's largest city without having to build another school.

The CWRU Medical School is the only private institution in Ohio receiving direct state student assistance.
