

Medical College To Honor Tandler Famed Anatomist Topic Of Seminar

The Medical College of Ohio will sponsor a seminar Wednesday to commemorate the 100th birthday anniversary of Julius Tandler, a Viennese doctor described as one of the most renowned anatomist in history.

Dr. Ernst Sternfeld, a practicing Toledo surgeon and associate clinical professor of surgery at the college, will be main speaker. Dr. Sternfeld, a graduate of the University of Vienna and a student of Dr. Tandler, who died in 1935, will discuss his former professor.

Ronald M. Watterson, college librarian, will preside at the seminar, to start with a reception at 5:30 p.m. in the East Laboratory, adjacent to William Roche Memorial Hospital. Dr. Liberato J. A. DiDio, chairman of the anatomy department, will introduce Dr. Sternfeld.

On display will be the original edition of "Tandler's Textbook of Systematic Anatomy."
