

CHAPTER 3350: TOLEDO STATE COLLEGE OF MEDICINE

§ 3350.01 Establishment of medical college of Ohio at Toledo; appointment and terms of trustees.

There is hereby created the medical college of Ohio at Toledo. The government of the medical college of Ohio at Toledo is vested in a board of nine trustees, who shall be appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent of the senate. Upon December 18, 1964, nine trustees shall be appointed immediately, one for a term ending May 1, 1965, one for a term ending May 1, 1966, one for a term ending May 1, 1967, one for a term ending May 1, 1968, one for a term ending May 1, 1969, one for a term ending May 1, 1970, one for a term ending May 1, 1971, one for a term ending May 1, 1972, and one for a term ending May 1, 1973. The successor of each such member shall be appointed for a term of nine years ending on the first day of May, except that any person appointed to fill a vacancy shall be appointed to serve only for the unexpired term. No person who has served a full nine-year term or more than six years of such a term shall be eligible to reappointment. The trustees shall receive no compensation for their services but shall be paid their reasonable necessary expenses while engaged in the discharge of their official duties. A majority of the board constitutes a quorum.

The provisions of § 2 of H 7 (130 v Pt. 2, 183) read as follows:

SECTION 2. Subject to rules and regulations adopted by the Ohio Board of Regents, the board of trustees of Toledo state college of medicine may enter into and fulfill contracts and agreements with the board of trustees of the university of Toledo relating to the use of lands, buildings, and equipment of the university of Toledo, and relating to any other purpose concerning the operation of Toledo state college of medicine.

§ 3350.02 Selection of officers; treasurer to give bond.

The board of trustees of the medical college of Ohio at Toledo shall annually elect from its members a chairman and a vice-chairman; and they may also appoint a secretary of the board, a treasurer, and such other officers of the college as the interest of the college requires, who may be members of the board. The treasurer, before entering upon the discharge of his duties, shall give bond to the state for the faithful performance of his duties and the proper accounting for all moneys coming into his care. The amount of said bond shall be determined by the board, but shall not be for a sum less than the estimated amount which may come into his control at any time. Said bond shall be approved by the attorney general.

§ 3350.03 Duties of the board of trustees.

The board of trustees of the medical college of Ohio at Toledo shall employ, fix the compensation of, and remove the president and such numbers of professors, teachers, and other employees as may be deemed necessary. The board shall do all things necessary for the creation, proper maintenance, and successful and continuous operation of the college. The board may accept donations of lands and moneys for the purposes of such college.

The board may cooperate with the boards of trustees of Bowling Green state university and the university of Toledo for the use of faculty, facilities, and programs.

any grant or devise of land, and any donation or bequest of money or other personal property, to be applied to the general or special use of the college, unless otherwise directed in the donation or bequest. The board of trustees of the medical college of Ohio at Toledo may make and enter into all contracts and agreements necessary or incidental to the operation of such college.

Title to any property taken in the name of the Toledo state college of medicine shall be deemed to have been taken in the name of the medical college of Ohio.

§ 3351.05 Ohio student loan commission defined.

There is hereby created a commission as the "Ohio student loan commission" the purpose of such commission is to assist residents of this state in their education and to improve the health and welfare by raising the educational standards of such residents by making loans to persons who are attending eligible institutions of higher learning. Such loans are made to assist in meeting their expenses of attending such institutions with the provisions of sections 3351.15, inclusive, of the Revised Code, "Education," as used in sections 3351.15, inclusive, of the Revised Code, university, college, or institution of higher education as well as
