Toledo, Ohio December 31, 1892.

To the Honorable the Common Council of the City of Toledo:

Gentlemen:

In accordance with the ordinance passed for the annexation of contiguous territory to the City of Toledo I have proceeded before the Board of County Commissioners of Lucas county and brought the matter to a successful determination, said board having approved of the ordinance and the annexation authorized by your honorable body.

I have caused the necessary transcript and papers relating to the action of said Board of County Commissioners to be filed with the recorder of Lucas county in accordance with law; said papers having been filed on Wednesday the 28th day of December, 1892. Before the same can be duly recorded and said territory thereby become a portion of this municipality the papers must remain on file in said recorder's office for sixty days.

Of course it will be necessary that there be a redistricting of the city into wards before the next municipal election, and as there will not be sufficient time after the expiration of the said sixty days to properly redistrict the city before said election, I call your attention to the fact and urge that you at once appoint proper committees for investigating this subject, so that should said annexation be accomplished at the end of said sixty days the necessary ordinance may at once be passed for redistricting said territory.
