Officers Set For Foundation

Medical School Unit Re-Elects Rawling

The Medical College of Ohio Foundation re-elected Dr. Frank F. A. Rawling as president for another year at its annual meeting Tuesday night.

Also re-elected were Dr. Maurice A. Schnitker, vice president; Dr. Gregor Sido, secretary, and John D. Willey, treasurer.

The foundation is an outgrowth of the original committee of physicians and interested citizens established to explore the prospects of creating a medical college here.

With the college now in operation, the foundation is redirecting its efforts toward building area-wide support for development and growth of the institution, one of the major potential health resources of northwest Ohio.

Named to three-year terms as trustees of the foundation at the Tuesday meeting were Dr. William S. Carlson, Michael J. Damas, James Slater Gibson, Dr. Saul Kelson, and Dr. Rawling. Dr. Rawling and Mr. Gibson also serve on the board of trustees of the new college.

William Bender, Jr., was named executive secretary of the foundation.

Trustees appointed a nominating committee to recommend names of persons to fill two vacancies on the board. Mr. Bender said they are expected to be chosen in the near future.
