President William S. Carlson, new administrator at the University of Toledo this fall, finds also that he has a majority of relatively new deans in the top academic posts at TU.

Of nine men carrying this rank, only three held these positions before 1955. They are Dr. Andrew J. Townsend, Arts and Sciences, senior dean who has headed that college since 1932; Dr. Charles W. Fornoff, Law dean since 1945, and Dr. Charles H. Larwood, Pharmacy dean since 1946.

Deans who have been in charge of colleges a year or less are Dr. George E. Dickson, Education, September, 1957; Dr. Otto Zmeskal, Engineering, January, 1958, and Dr. Edwin R. Hodge, Business Administration, September, 1958.

The remaining three occupy new deanships were created only recently. Dr. Archie N. Solberg, a faculty member since 1937, was named Dean of Research in 1955; Dr. Arnold E. Hanson, who came to TU in 1951, was appointed Dean of Academic Administration in 1955, and Dr. Ralph C. Kendall, at TU since 1955, was named Dean of Adult and Continuing Education in 1957.

Three assistant deans of colleges have been appointed within the last year also. They are Dr. Louis Hough, Arts and Sciences; Dr. Anthony DeIulio, Education, and Ernest W. Weaver, Jr., Engineering.
