A total of 224 University of Toledo students will receive degrees at commencement ceremonies to be held on Sunday (August 30) at 3 p.m. in TU's Doermann Theater. Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president, will deliver the charge to the graduates.

The candidates include William L. Hoover, 4614 McCord Rd., Sylvania, who will receive the first doctor of philosophy degree ever awarded by TU. He received the BA degree from Wayne State University and the MA from Wheaton College.

Also scheduled to receive a doctorate is Marianne H. Mitchell, 511 Carver Blvd. Miss Mitchell, who received her bachelor's and master's degrees at TU, is the fourth TU student to receive the doctor of education degree. She has accepted a position as assistant professor of counselor education at Central Michigan University.

In addition to the two doctoral degrees, 90 master's degrees, 128 bachelor's degrees and 4 associate (2-year) degrees will be awarded.

Because of limited seating capacity in Doermann Theater admission to the Sunday program will be ticket only.
