Dear Vic:

In response to your recent Tuition Questionnaire, I have the following information.

We have had ten Union members benefit from the Tuition refund program. Most courses are job related.

One Laboratory Assistant took College courses of "Liberal Arts" and received a two year Associate Degree.

Another Laboratory Assistant took a College Math course.

Another Clerk took "Inventory and Production Control" course.

An Instrument Technician took "Industrial Communication" course at college, but no college credit is given for this subject.

The above people are all on non-exempt salary.

A First Class Instrument Mechanic is taking a Management Development Certificate Program at the University of Delaware. It is about a two or three year program and if completed, he will get a certificate. He is now a Temporary Supervisor. He has about three years service with the Company.

An Instrument Mechanic Trainee has taken an Instrument course and three Electricians have taken a National Electric Code and Blue Print Reading course, all at a local Vocational School. These last five people are all on Wage Roll. They all have received their Tuition refunds. This is all the information I have at this time.
