Medical School Role Is Topic

Meeting Slated At Bowling Green

Educators and medical society representatives from northwestern Ohio will meet Monday at 6 p.m. in the Holiday Inn, Bowling Green, to discuss ways the Medical College of Ohio can serve area health needs.

A major portion of the meeting will be devoted to discussion of plans for a community of medical scholars that will include practicing physicians, interns, residents, medical students, and faculty.

Invited to the meeting are Dr. Robert G. Page, dean, and Dr. Howard S. Madigan, assistant dean, of the college, and presidents of medical societies and physicians responsible for medical education programs.
