Three committees for planning and expansion were named at the University of Toledo today by President William S. Carlson. The committees, which had been meeting informally prior to the official appointments, are working on the three top-priority projects as submitted earlier to the Board of Regents. These are a science building, an addition to the Engineering-Science building, and a University Community and Technical College building.

The committees are: Science Building Planning Committee; Alfred Foster, chairman, and John Donahue, biology; Nelson W. Hovey, chemistry; William A. Kneller, geology; John J. Turin, physics; Harvard L. Armus, psychology; Robert J. Schlembach, pharmacy; and C. C. Ackerman, assistant to the president.

Engineering-Science building Expansion Committee: Ernest W. Weaver, Jr., chairman, and George L. Heath, mechanical; R. A. Chipman, electrical; Norman Sedlander, civil; Gary Bennett, chemical; Milton A. Netter, Jr., industrial; and John J. Turin, physics.

University Community and Technical College Planning Committee: Newton C. Rochte, chairman, and J. Philip Dalby, Wesley Hale, Dan Seeman, Charles Kinnison, Betty Hartley, Darrell Cole and Eugene Shinavar. This committee has as its adviser President Winston D. Purvine of the Oregon Technical Institute (Klamath Falls), who is a member of the national accreditation committee of the Engineers Council for Professional Development.

TU's Planning and Development Committee, headed by Dr. David Rosenberger, currently is considering sites for new buildings. And President Carlson said architects for each of the proposed buildings will be named soon.
