TOLEDO, Ohio — Dr. Nicolas Rashevsky, University of Michigan professor of mathematical biology and psychology and research mathematical biologist in the U-M Mental Health Research Institute, was appointed consulting research professor of mathematical biology at the Ohio College of Medicine in Toledo this week.

The board of trustees of the Toledo school also appointed Dr. Robert W. Muenzer, a former staff member at University Hospital in Ann Arbor and 1944 graduate of the U-M Medical School, assistant clinical professor of obstetrics and gynecology. Dr. Muenzer has been in private practice in Toledo since 1951.
