Approximately \$150,000 in library acquisitions are being made possible at The University of Toledo through gifts of stock by Owens-Corning Fiberglas Corp. officials.

Over a period of years 1,200 shares were contributed by W. Paul Zimmerman, retired director and executive vice president, and 675 shares by Harry Winkle, director.

Dr. William S. Carlson, University president, received the donors' permission to use the securities for library acquisitions. The purchases will strengthen holdings of published material for doctoral programs offered by the University.

He said this is a splendid example of the value of unrestricted gifts which then can be used to meet University needs in areas where other funds are not readily available. Dr. Carlson praised the donors for their willingness to agree to use their funds for this important purpose, and for their continuing interest in the programs of the University.
