One thing we get plenty of is bananas. For one pack of cigarettes you can get 60-70 bananas. Sure wish I could send some home. Ill bet Susie would sure like that. Are bananas very hard to

In your last letter you said the first football game had been played. How did it come out. You asked about the Press & Times and their coming through okay now.
