At a meeting of the Toledo Charter Commission on September 4, 1928, the enclosed certificate was approved by the Charter Commission and signed by the members present.

Those members absent and who approved the proposed charter, S. D. Vinmedge and C. D. Selby, were given the opportunity by a resolution of the Commission to sign the certificate, which they did today, S. D. Vinmedge in person and C. D. Selby through Virgil Sheppard.

This certificate explains the clerical change which the Commission desires to make in the proposed charter approved by the Commission under date of July 30, 1928.

In order to correct a clerical error in Section No. 12 of the Charter approved by the Charter Commission of the City of Toledo under date of July 30, 1928, and to make clear the intent of the Commission that said Section should, among other things, provide for a minimum of seven members of the City Council, Virgil Sheppard, Secretary of the Charter Commission, is hereby authorized and directed to strike out the word "last" and also to strike out the word "continuing" from the sentence in said Section 12 in said Charter as heretofore certified by the Commission, reading as follows:

"If at any election fewer than seven (7) candidates receive the required quota, the last seven (7) continuing candidates remaining after all others have been declared defeated and their ballots transferred shall all be elected whether they have received the full quota or not,"

so that said sentence, as corrected to conform to the intent and purpose of the Charter Commission, will read:

"If at any election fewer than seven (7) candidates receive the required quota, the seven (7) candidates remaining after all others have been declared defeated and their ballots transferred shall all be elected whether they have received the full quota or not,"

The undersigned, members of the Charter Commission by whose approval said Charter was adopted and certified under date of July 30, 1928, hereby certify that the foregoing correction is in accord with their intent and purpose in approving and certifying said Charter, and is made for the purpose of removing any possible ambiguity of said language.

The Clerk of Council of the City of Toledo is hereby requested and directed to make said correction in any and all printed copies of said Charter furnished to the electors of the City of Toledo.

September 4, 1928.

The undersigned, a majority of the Committee appointed at the meeting of the Charter Commission held July 30th, 1928, to "act upon any further business which might come before the Charter Commission" hereby authorize the foregoing correction and join in the above direction to the Clerk of Council.
