Dr. William S. Carlson, president of the University of Toledo, has been elected president of the TU Research Foundation. He is the first TU president to hold this position since the Foundation was organized in 1946.

Other officers for 1959 are Urban E. Bowes, vice president; James D. Bain, secretary-treasurer, and Dr. Archie N. Solberg, executive director.

Eleven new members of the Research Foundation Corporation were elected by the trustees. These are: Dr. Joseph Judis, Dr. George Dickson, Philip H. Hensel and Dr. Otto Zmeskal of the TU faculty; Dr. Edward Doermann, Bernard Cousion, Dr. Vance Dodson and Dr. Sol Boyk from the alumni of the university, and Henry Heyn, L.E. Johnson and Robert Christie from local industry.

The trustees approved a budget of \$120,00 for the year. Included in this is a new item of \$5000 to support unsponsored research by faculty members. Dr. Carlson said this would be helpful in areas not in the defense or scientific fields where funds from outside sources are difficult to get.

The budget also provides for a contribution of \$15,000 for general overhead expenses to be paid to the university.

Dr. Solberg reported a net of \$14,000 in excess of expenses during 1958.

Serving on the board of trustees are Randolph Barnard, Walter A. Eversman, Charles E. Ide, W.W. Knight, Jr., Jules D. Lippmann, James Nicholson, Frank Pitt, Duane Stranahan, Mr. Bowes and Dr. Carlson.
