Commencement ceremonies for The University of Toledo's 83rd academic year will be held on Thursday (June 9) at 7:30 p.m. in the TU Field House. A total of 627\* persons are candidates for degrees.

Named to receive honorary doctor of laws degrees are John Marshall Briley, chairman of the Ohio Board of Regents; Dr. John D. Millett, chancellor of the Ohio Board of Regents; and Dr. Harold W. Oyster, former chairman of the Regents and currently vice president for development at the University of Akron.

Three TU faculty members will be named professor emeritus at the program. They are Charles A. Felker, associate professor of vocational education; Dr. Charles Larwood, dean of the College of Pharmacy; and Dr. James Southworth, professor of English.

Four TU faculty members, named to receive awards for Outstanding Teaching, will be presented with citations and prizes of \$1,000 each.

Among those receiving degrees at the ceremonies are three doctoral candidates. They are Byron F. Radebaugh and Doris Siegel, who will receive the doctor of education degree, and Charles W. Ryan, who will receive the doctor of philosophy degree in education.

Dr. William S. Carlson, TU president, will confer the degrees and will deliver the commencement address. The TU concert band, under the direction of Samuel P. Szor, will present a half hour concert, beginning at 7 p.m. in the Field House.
