WHEREAS, Assistance Dogs of America, Inc. begun in 1984 under the name of Guide Dogs for the Handicapped, Inc.; and

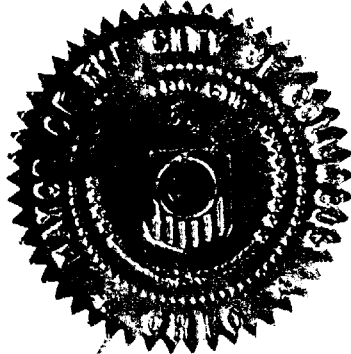
