

Sponsorship of Legislation
118th General Assembly
Representative Casey Jones

Representative Casey Jones has served 22 years in the Ohio Legislature and serves as Chairman of the Local Government Committee, and is a member of the Finance, Energy and Environment, and Rules Committees. He is responsible for the following sponsorship of legislation:

- House Bill 186 dedicates Interstate 475 as the "Rosa Parks Highway."
- House Bill 187 permits counties to replace furnances in low-income homes and use taxes collected on alcohol and tabbaco products for funding.
- House Bill 278 was legislated for the study on water resource management.
*This bill was later taken out due to allocation of funds obtained through the budget bill, H.B. 111.
- House Bill 416 creates Nursing Home Inspection Committee to inspect nursing homes and report problems to the Department of Health and the Attorney General, to increase the nursing home annual renewal licensing and inspection fee to cover the operating costs of the Committee.
- House Bill 630 require vehicles for sale in the State of Ohio to have a front license plate location.

LEGISLATION TENURE

Bills Sponsored

109th G.A. 1970 - 1971

- Bill passed to permit oral examination for MV operation to be given to those who don't speak English.
- Bill passed to provide compensation for persons killed or injured while rendering assistance to victims of crime.
- Bill makes seaman eligible for unemployment compensation.
- Bill requires the licensure and regulation of agricultural labor camps.

110th G.A. 1972 - 1973

- Bill to have Port Authority provide group life insurance.

111th G.A. 1974 - 1975

- Bill passed to force school curriculum in state to study minority groups.
- Bill to have extra leave for state employees injured on the job.
- Bill to require once certain conditions are met, the expungement of the record of the conviction of a person who commits not more than two misdemeanors.
- Bill to model power of attorney--small property interest act.

113th G.A. 1978 - 1979

- Bill to require Boards of Education to use zero-base budgeting techniques and require them to be renewed by the state board for study.
- Bill to recognize the validity of collectively bargained contracts between public employees and employers.
- Bill to memorialize Congress to fund completely public assistance and medicade programs.
- Bill to designate Dr. King's birthday a national holiday.

114th G.A. 1980 - 1981

- Bill to convey state land to City of Toledo for recreation purposes.
- Bill passed to remove from the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission moter vehicles designed to carry no more than 15 passenger and used to transport persons between their places of of residence and employment in a car pool.
